The Welsh-American Genealogical Society, Inc. (WAGS) is based in Poultney, Vermont. It was founded in the last 10 years "for the purpose of offering assistance to individuals who are searching their Welsh roots." WAGS publishes a newsletter that contains interesting articles on Welsh research and genealogy in general. The newsletter also includes queries.

Recently, Green Mountain College in Poultney, Vermont donated a room in its Griswold Library for a WAGS library. The library will include family histories, Welsh and Welsh-American histories, and books by Welsh authors. Book and monetary donations are now welcome. The Griswold Library also houses a "Welsh Room" that includes local Welsh history.
